FEES AND CHARGES INFORMATION

Any person applying to be accepted as a resident at Nazareth Care Christchurch must first be assessed on behalf of the Ministry of Health and have a Notification of Needs Assessment and Service Coordination form lodged on their behalf. Nazareth Care can only accept residents who have been assessed as requiring Rest Home Level Care, Hospital Level Care and End of Life Care.

Bed Fee Schedule

We have a mix of both Standard Premium and Premium Rooms.

*The Maximum Contribution is the maximum amount that a resident assessed as requiring long-term residential care (through NASC) is required to pay. It is the same for all residents regardless of the type of contracted care services they receive. The maximum contribution set by the New Zealand Gazette notice applies from 1 July 2022 and replaces the previous maximum contribution notice published in the New Zealand Gazette, 29 July 2021, Notice No. 2021-go3187.

**It is recommended that any person seeking care at Nazareth Care obtain a Financial Means Assessment prior to commencing residency at Nazareth Care as this will determine the total amount that is to be paid by the resident and the total amount that will be paid as funding by the Ministry of Health. Assessment is obtained through lodging the Residential Care Subsidy Financial Means Assessment Application Form. If this assessment is not lodged the resident will be classed as a Private Payer and will be responsible for the full cost of their care. The resident should lodge an application with Work & Income if part of their care fees is to be paid via a contribution by Work & Income. If a resident is not eligible to receive the Residential Care Subsidy, they may be eligible for a Residential Care Loan.
